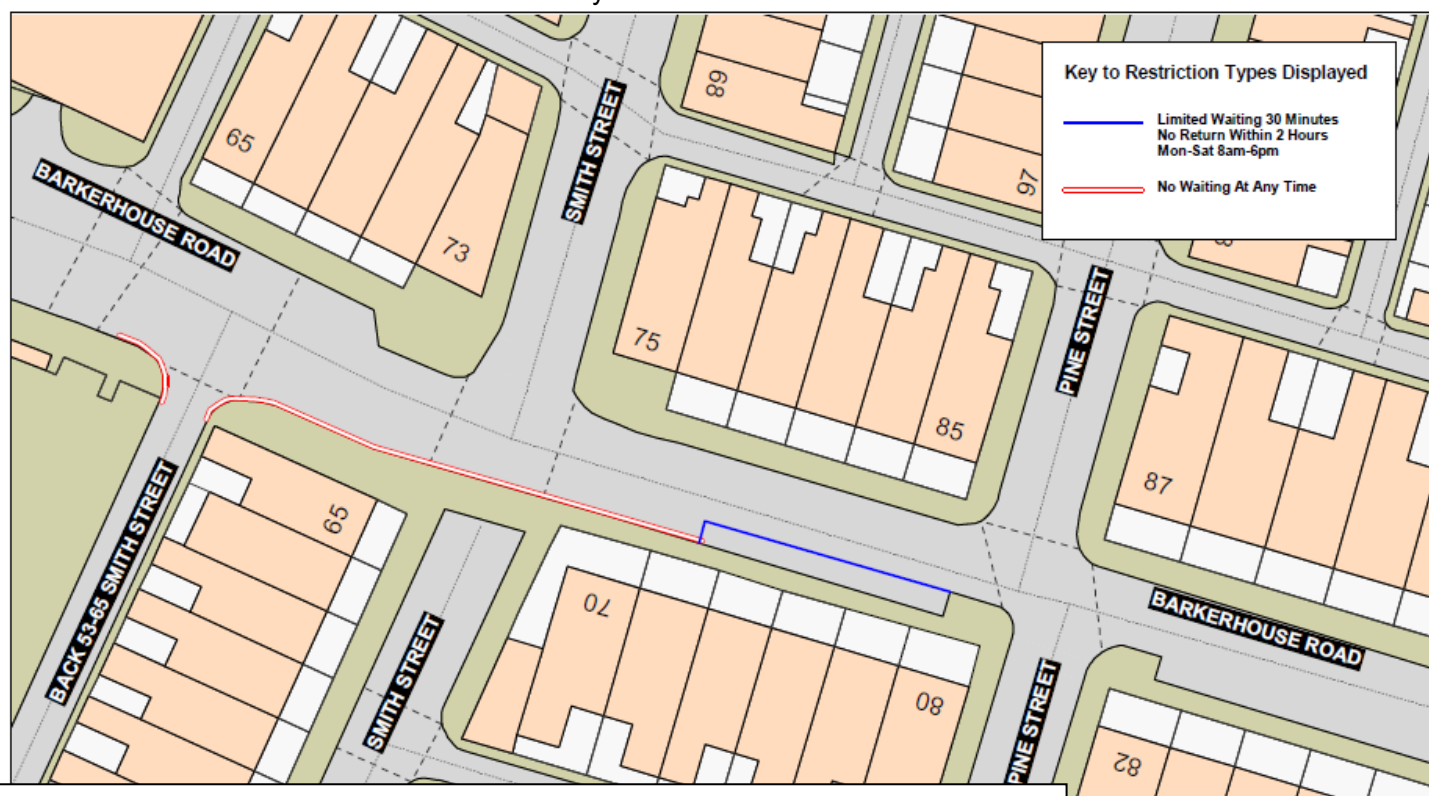


NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BARKERHOUSE ROAD, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 202*



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 05 September 2025 and 03 October 2025, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

Introduce a limited waiting parking place for 30 minutes with no return within 2 hours Monday to Saturday 8am – 6pm in Barkerhouse Road, Nelson, the south side, from a point 17.5 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Smith Street for a distance of 20 metres in a south easterly direction.

Statement of Reasons

Having considered the objection and feedback, it is proposed to make the following changes the consulted proposal. It is now proposed to introduce a new extent of Limited Waiting 30 minutes, no return within 2 hours between 8am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday outside of residences 72 – 80 Barkerhouse Road. The purpose of this proposal is to ensure there is sufficient short-term parking for vehicles of road users seeking to use the local businesses.
