(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of
 - Rydal Grove, Knott End-On-Sea from its junction with Coniston Avenue to it junction with Grange Close.
 - ii. Coniston Avenue, Knott End-On-Sea from its junction with Rydal Grove for 10 metres in either direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2359 hours on Saturday 8th November 2025 until 2359 hours on Friday 14th November or until completion of the works within this period.
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent excavations to repair leaking sewer in the carriageway works to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Services on behalf of United Utilities.
