

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CHARTER LANE AND LILY AVENUE, CHARNOCK RICHARD, CHORLEY
BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- a) Charter Lane, Charnock Richard, the north east side, from a point 165.5 metres south east of its junction with the Centreline of Church Lane for a distance of 50 metres in a south easterly direction;
- b) Lily Avenue, Charnock Richard, both sides, from its junction with the Centreline of Charter Lane for a distance of 12.5 metres in a north easterly direction.
