**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Rear 2 to 28 Barry Street, Burnley from a point outside rear of 21 Barry Street travelling in either direction for approximately 15 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1400 hours on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2025 until 2359 hours on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent excavation carriageway to replace a leaking stop tap works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Untied Utilities.
