## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(BRADSHAW LANE & BACK LANE, MAWDESLEY, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following length of highway:
  - a. Bradshaw Lane, Mawdesley from its junction with Ridley Lane to where it merges with Back Lane, Mawdesley.
  - b. Back Lane, Mawdesley from where it merges with Bradshaw Lane to outside Prescott's Cottage, Back Lane, Mawdesley.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 to 1800 hours on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> December until Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Back Lane, Maltkiln Lane, Jay Bank, High Street, New Street, Hall Lane, Dark Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway pre surface dressing patching works to be carried out.
