(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Pleasant Street, Lytham St Annes from its junction with North Clifton Street to its junction with South Westby Street.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1530 hours on Thursday 13th November 2025 until 2359 hours on Monday 17th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent excavation to repair a fault on an existing LV main to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
