(HALIFAX ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Halifax Road, Burnley from its junction with Robin House Lane to its boundary with Herd House Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on Thursday 8th January 2026 until 1500 hours on Friday 9th January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Robin House Lane, Southfield Lane, Back Lane, Halifax Road- Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Telcom pole maintenance works to be carried out by Dutton Traffic Management Services on behalf of Morrison Telecom Services.
