NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear 3 to 29 Lee Street, Burnley from the rear of 29 Lee Street to the rear of 21 Lee Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 12th January 2026 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 14th January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Hebrew Road, Allen Street- Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow disconnection of old water main and replaced with a new water connection works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
