(HIGH MOOR LANE.WRIGHTINGTON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of High Moor Lane, Wrightington to a point 455 metres east of its junction with Harrock Lane for a distance of 20 metres in an easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1400 hours on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> November until 1600 hours on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency excavation works to be carried out to replace a leaking water meter.
