(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

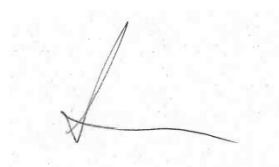
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Goose Lane, Chipping from a point outside the Sports Pavillion travelling in a southerly direction for approximately 400 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1500 hours on Sunday 18th January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for bus services and emergency services.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Mill Lane – Parkinson Lane – Parsonage Lane - Garstang Road – Talbot Street – Windy Street – Longridge Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Openreach on behalf of British Telecom to carry out essential works on their assets.
