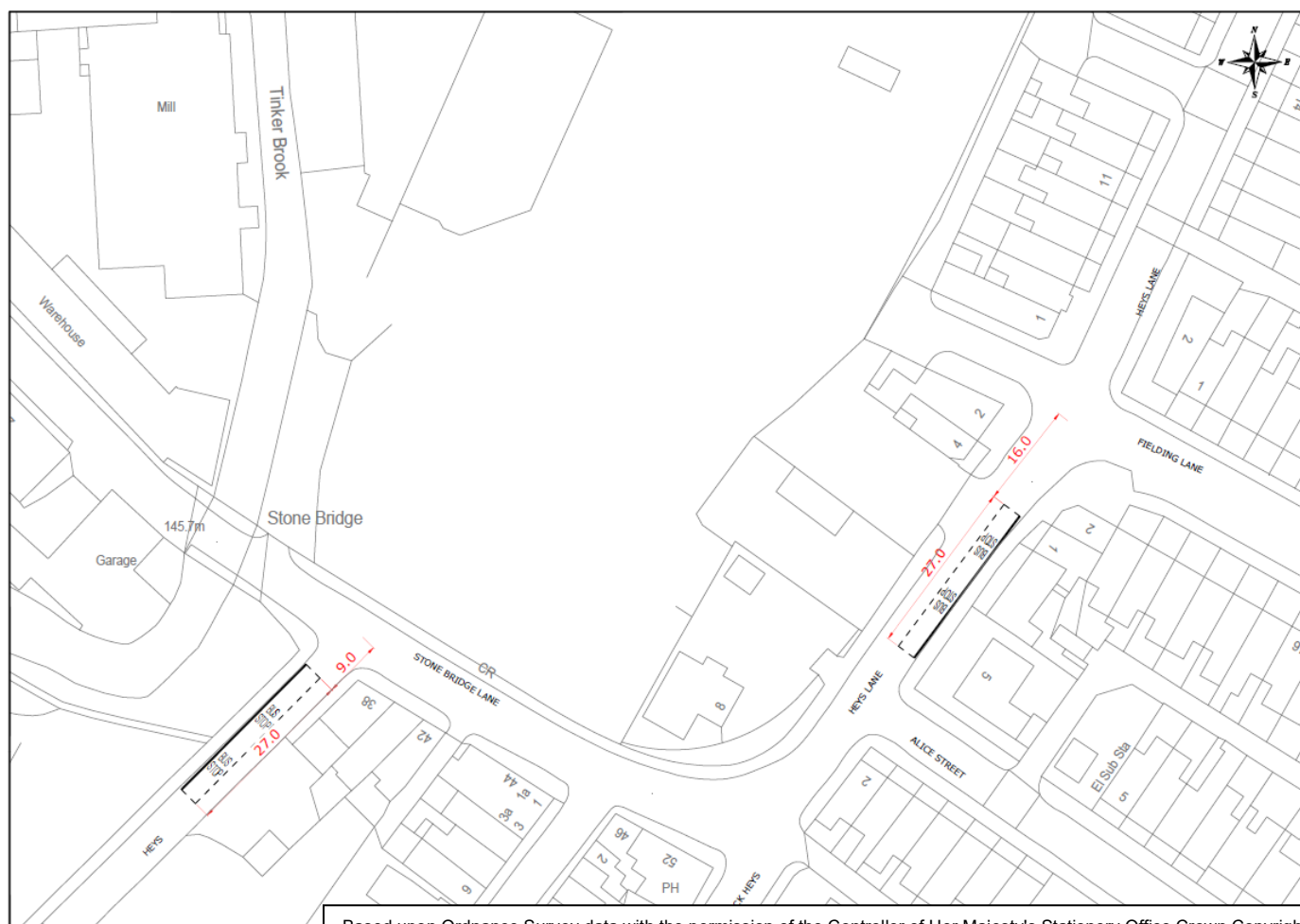


**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(HEYS LANE AND HEYS, OSWALDTWISTLE, HYNDBURN**  
**BOROUGH) (BUS STOP CLEARWAYS)**



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce Bus Stop Clearways at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:

- 1) Heys Lane, Oswaldtwistle, the south east side, from a point 16 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Fielding Lane for a distance of 27 metres in a south westerly direction;
- 2) Heys, Oswaldtwistle, the north west side, from a point 9 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Stone Bridge Lane for a distance of 27 metres in a south westerly direction.



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**Statement of Reasons**

The purpose of this proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stops on Heys and Heys Lane at Oswaldtwistle, with enforceable clearway markings and signs, allowing buses to pull in safely and efficiently at the stop.

The proposal intends to promote sustainable transport for all users by including the construction of a raised platform, allowing safe boarding and alighting of passengers.

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development.
