## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(BACK BRENNAND STREET, CLITHEROE, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back Brennand Street, Clitheroe from its junction with Church Close to its junction with Railway View Avenue.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2025 until 1630 hours on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Railway View Avenue – King Street – Railway View Road – St Marys Street – Church Close – Brennand Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Electricity North West to carry out new customer connection works.
