THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(A49 PRESTON ROAD, COPPULL AND CHARNOCK RICHARD AND CROSTON LANE, CHARNOCK RICHARD, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT AND RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER 1997.

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- The length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- 3. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (A49 Preston Road, Coppull and Charnock Richard and Croston Lane, Charnock Richard, Chorley Borough) (40mph Speed Limit and Restricted Road) Order 1997 and shall come into force on the 26th August, 1997.

THE COMMON SEAL of the Lancashire County Council was hereunto affixed in pursuance of a Resolution passed at a meeting of the Highways and Transportation Committee duly convened and held on the 13th March, 1996.

SCHEDULE 1

- 1. A49 Preston Road from a point 310 metres north of its junction with Burwell Avenue, Coppull, in a northbound direction to a point 78 metres north of the junction with Mill Lane, Charnock Richard, a distance of approximately 1130 metres.
- Croston Lane, Charnock Richard, from its junction with A49 Preston Road for a distance of 120 metres in a south westerly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

A49 Preston Road, Coppull, from a point 165 metres south of its junction with Coppull Moor Lane (the termination of the existing 40mph limit) in a northerly direction to a point 310 metres north of its junction with Burwell Avenue.
