THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(A675 BOLTON ROAD, ABBEY VILLAGE, WITHNELL, CHORLEY BOROUGH)
(REVOCATION AND RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER, 1997.

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Lancashire County Council (A675 Bolton Road, Abbey Village, Chorley Borough) (Consolidation) and (40mph and 50mph Speed Limit) Order, 1993, is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (A675 Bolton Road, Abbey Village, Withnell, Chorley Borough) (Revocation and Restricted Road) Order 1997 and shall come into force on the 10th February, 1997.

A675 Bolton Road, Abbey Village, from a point 87 metres south east of its junction with Dole Lane to a point 339 metres north west of its junction with Garden Street, a distance of approximately 700 metres.
