(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (NO. 3) ORDER 1988

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Bannister Lane and Woodhart Lane, Eccleston, Chorley Borough) (30 mph Speed Limit) (No. 3) Order 1988" and shall come into operation on the 5th August, 1988.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of road at Eccleston, Chorley Borough

1. That length of Bannister Lane from its junction with B5250 The Green to a point 20 metres south of its southerly junction with Woodhart Lane, a distance of approximately 330 metres.
2. That length of Woodhart Lane from its junction with B5250 The Green to its southerly junction with Bannister Lane, a distance of approximately 200 metres.
