

THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(GIB LANE, HOGHTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH)  
(RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER, 1994.

Lancashire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Gib Lane, Hoghton, Chorley Borough) (Restricted Road) Order, 1994 and shall come into force on the 26th September, 1994.
2. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

**SCHEDULE**

Gib Lane, Hoghton, from its junction with A675 Hoghton Lane northwards to a point 12 metres north of its junction with Cripple Gate Lane, a distance of approximately 750 metres including the full length of the loop road to the west of Gib Lane.
