

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967 THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF LANCASTER (RESTRICTED ROADS) (NO.10) ORDER 1971.

The County Council of the County Palatine of Lancaster in exercise of their powers under sections 72(3) and 73(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County Palatine of Lancaster, hereby order and direct as follows:-

- 1. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. This Order may be cited as the County Council of Lancaster (Restricted Roads) (No.10) Order 1971 and shall come into operation on the seventh day of June, 1971.

## SCHEDULE

Length of road in the Parish of Clayton-le-Woods in the Rural District of Chorley

That length of Lancaster Lane, B.5256, Clayton-le-Woods, which extends from its junction with Wigan Road, (A.49), to a point 75 yards east of its junction with Shady Lane, a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 1,085 yards.
