- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Empress Street, Accrington from its boundary from number 27 Empress Street, Accrington for a distance of 50 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Monday 24th November until 1500 hours on Wednesday 26th November 2026 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 9th August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow sewer repairs works carried out by United Utilities.
