(SAUNDERS LANE, HUTTON, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Saunders Lane, Hutton from a point 145 metres in a southerly direction from its junction with A59 Longton Bypass, Hutton for a distance of 65 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Monday 2nd February 2026 until 1630 hours on Tuesday 3rd February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Saunders Lane - Chapel Lane - A59 Longton Bypass - Saunders Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out.
