(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

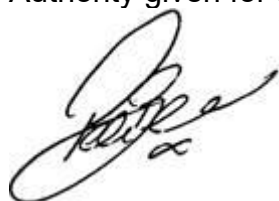
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Saunders Lane, Hutton from a point 145 metres in a southerly direction from its junction with A59 Longton Bypass, Hutton for a distance of 65 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Monday 2nd February 2026 until 1630 hours on Tuesday 3rd February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Saunders Lane – Chapel Lane - A59 Longton Bypass – Saunders Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out.
