## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(SHIRLEY LANE, LONGTON, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Shirley Lane, Longton from its junction with Liverpool Road, Longton for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2026 until 1700 hours on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Shirley Lane – Landsmoor Drive – Franklands – Liverpool Road and Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out.
