(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

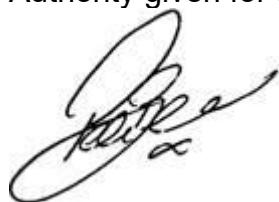
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Shirley Lane, Longton from its junction with Liverpool Road, Longton for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 19th January 2026 until 1700 hours on Sunday 1st February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Shirley Lane – Landsmoor Drive – Franklands – Liverpool Road and Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out.
