(COCKERHAM ROAD AND WALLACE LANE, FORTON, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of
 - i. Cockerham Road, Forton from outside Cross Hill to outside Longsands.
 - ii. Wallace Lane, Forton from its junction with Cockerham Road to outside number 35.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Tuesday 20th January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
 - i. A6 Preston Lancaster Road – School Lane – Cockerham Road and vice versa.
 - ii. Wallace Lane – School Lane – Cockerham Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the safety of operatives to carry out pole testing works on behalf of Openreach.
