(SCAITCLIFFE STREET, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Scaitcliffe Street, Accrington from 20 metres either side of the railway bridge
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1000 hours to 1500 hours on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Scaitcliffe Street – Eagle Street – Blackburn Road – Scaitcliffe Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessesary to allow bridge examination works undertaken by Network Rail.
