Something to do this week! Find out about Lancashire Family Hubs

Family Hubs are a national initiative that aim to ensure all families have access to the same high-quality services and supportive relationships within their local area. Support is available for all stages of family life, from pregnancy through to 19 years old, or 25 for those with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND).

Family Hubs work together with partner organisations such as NHS or schools to provide help and advice. Families can access support and information on a wide range of subjects such as:

- midwife and health visitor appointments
- groups for expectant mums and dads
- counselling for families
- baby feeding advice
- SEND support groups and advice

FAMILY HUBS NETWORK

Sharing information about Family Hubs with parents when they first join your setting is a helpful way to introduce early support services. By making them aware of where they can access help, you reassure families that support is available as soon as any concerns arise.
