LANGLEY LANE, INGLEWHITE, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Langley Lane, Inglewhite from outside of Simfield Cottages for approximately 650 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 9th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
- 6. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Langley Lane - Inglewhite Road - Derby Road - Whittingham Road - Cumeragh Lane - Whittingham Lane - Langley Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out.
