(LONGMEANYGATE, LEYLAND, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Longmeanygate, Leyland from a point directly outside property number 190a Longmeanygate, Leyland for a distance of 150 metres in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1700 hours on Monday 9th February 2026 until Friday 27th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Longmeanygate - B5248 Dunkirk Lane - B5253 Schleswig Way – Comet Road – Reiver Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works to be carried out to install and joint cable for new connection.
