(RESTRICTED ROADS) ORDER 1994

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Blackpool Old Road and Cartford Lane, Little Eccleston with Larbreck, Out Rawcliffe and Great Eccleston, Fylde and Wyre Boroughs) (Restricted Roads) Order 1994 and shall come into force on the 7th February 1994.
- The lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

SCHEDULE

- 1. The full length of Blackpool Old Road from its westerly junction with A586 to its easterly junction with A586.
- The full length of Cartford Lane from its junction with Blackpool Old Road to its junction with the Class (III) Road (C400) approximately 60 metres north of Cartford Bridge.
