

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BRYNING LANE / CHURCH ROAD, WARTON, FYLDE BOROUGH)
(PART REVOCATION AND RESTRICTED ROAD 30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2013**

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82 (2), 83 (2), 84(1)(a) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. Part Revocation

That part of the "The Lancashire County Council (Warton Area, Warton (Various Roads) Fylde Borough) (Revocation, 20mph and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2011", insofar as it relates to Bryning Lane / Church Road, Warton, from a point 30 metres north of the centre line of its junction with Hillock Lane to a point 115 metres west of the junction with Marlborough Avenue, Fylde Borough, is hereby revoked.

2. Restricted Road (30mph Speed Limit will apply)

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along Bryning Lane / Church Road, Warton, from a point 30 metres north of the centre line of its junction with Hillock Lane to a point 115 metres north west of the junction with Marlborough Avenue, Fylde Borough, which shall become a restricted road (as defined in section 82 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984).

3. Exemption

"No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations".

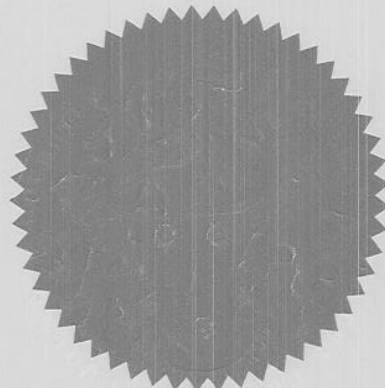
4. Commencement of Order

This Order may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Bryning Lane / Church Road, Warton, Fylde Borough) (Part Revocation and Restricted Road 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2013" and shall come into force on the 10th day of June 2013".
