ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STAINING AREA, STAINING (VARIOUS ROADS, FYLDE BOROUGH) (REVOCATION, 20MPH AND 30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2012

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. Revocation

- i. "The Lancashire County Council (Restricted Roads) (No.3) Order 1979", is hereby revoked, in full.
- ii. "The County Council of Lancaster (Built Up Areas) (No.3) Order 1960", is hereby revoked, in full.
- iii. "The Lancashire County Council (Mill Lane/Staining Old Road/Smithy Lane, Staining, Fylde Borough) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2005", is hereby revoked, in full.
- iv. "The Lancashire County Council (Restricted Roads) (No.2) Order 1967", is hereby revoked, in full.

2. 20mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any of the roads or lengths of road set out in the schedule to this Order, located within the Staining Area, Fylde Borough.

3. Restricted Road (30mph Speed Limit will apply)

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of road which shall become restricted Roads (as defined in section 82 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984):

i. Chain Lane from a point 105 metres north of Chain Bridge to a point 363 metres north of Chain Bridge, Fylde Borough.

4. 30mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along:

- i. **Smithy Lane** from its junction with Mill Lane to a point 100 metres north east of its junction with Mill Lane, Fylde Borough.
- ii. Mill Lane / Staining Old Road from a point on Mill Lane 104 metres north of its junction with castle Lane to a point on Old Staining Road 166 metres north of the junction with Smithy Lane, Fylde Borough.

5. Exemption

No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.

6. Commencement of Order

This Order may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Staining Area, Staining (Various Roads), Fylde Borough) (Revocation, 20mph and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2012" and shall come into force on the 6th day of June 2012.
