LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN ROSEACRE, TREALES AND WHARLES, FYLDE BOROUGH) (RESTRICTED ROAD AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2003

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Restricted Road

The lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall each be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

2. 40mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

3. Commencement of Order

This Order may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads In Roseacre, Treales And Wharles, Fylde Borough) (Restricted Road and 40mph Speed limit) Order 2003 and shall come into force on the 10th November, 2003.

SCHEDULE 1

 Roseacre Road, Roseacre, from a point 69.5 metres west of the western boundary of Ingledene to a point 68.5 metres east of the eastern boundary of Briar Croft a distance of 436 metres

2. Wharles

- (a) Roseacre Road, from its junction with Inskip Road for a distance of 402.5 metres in a westerly direction;
- (b) Inskip Road, from a point 200 metres south-west of the centreline of Roseacre Road for a distance of 270 metres in a north-easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

40mph speed limit on the following lengths of roads in Treales:-

- (a) Carr Lane, from its junction with Kirkham Road for a distance of 137 metres in a southerly direction;
- (b) Kirkham Road, for its whole length, from the centreline of Carr Lane to its junction with Treales Road;
- (c) Church Road, from the centreline of Kirkham Road for a distance of 96.5 metres in a northerly direction;

(d) Treales Road, from its junction with Moss Lane West for a distance of 100 metres In an easterly direction;

(e) Spen Lane, from its junction with Kirkham Road for a distance of 168 metres in a south westerly direction, to a point 18.5 metres south east of the southerly boundary of "Tanglewood."
