(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Salwick Road, Treales, Roseacre and Wharles from its junction with Inskip Road to outside Silverstone.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2026 until 1630 hours on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Church Road – Treales Road – Dagger Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out by Morrisons Telecom Services on behalf of BT.
