(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Brooke Street, Chorley from a point 20 metres either side of the railway bridge.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from
 - i. 2300 hours on Saturday 31st January 2026 until 0700 hours on Sunday 1st February 2026
 - ii. 2300 hours on Saturday 7th February 2026 until 0700 hours on Sunday 8th February 2026
 - iii. 2300 hours on Saturday 14th February 2026 until 0700 hours on Sunday 15th February 2026
 - iv. 2300 hours on Saturday 21st February 2026 until 0700 hours on Sunday 22nd February 2026
 - v. 2300 hours on Saturday 28th February 2026 until 0700 hours on Sunday 1st March 2026
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Brooke Street – Eaves Lane – B6228 Lyons Lane - A6 Lyons Lane South and Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Brickwork repair works to be carried out on the overbridge abutment.
