(CHURCH LANE, BILSBORROW, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Church Lane, Bilsborrow from its junction with Garstang Road to its junction with Ballot Hill Crescent.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 16th February 2026 until 1800 hours on Friday 20th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Church Lane - Bilsborrow Lane - Garstang Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow open cut excavation required to rebuild defective chamber causing a potential hazard in the carriageway works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
