## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SAVICK WAY, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on 04 December 2025 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- a) Savick Way (Bus Turning Circle), Preston, both sides, from a point 30 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Miller Field for a distance of 66 metres in a northerly then southerly direction within the bus turning circle;
- b) Savick Way, Preston, the north west side, from a point 44.5 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Miller Field for a distance of 17.5 metres on a north easterly direction.

This Order will come into force on the 15 December 2025.
