

<u>Dialogic Reading – CROWD Strategies</u>

C Completion Prompts	The adult leaves a blank at the end of the sentence and children complete orally by filling in the missing word or words. Consider focusing on language structures, such as rhyming words and repetition.
R Recall Prompts	The adult asks questions about what is happening in the book or what happened earlier to prompt recall. Consider focusing on the plot and sequencing of the text.
O Open – ended Prompts	The adult invites children to express their ideas by asking open – ended questions. Consider using the prompts, I can see Tell me more I wonder I think
W Wh Prompts	The adult asks what, where, when, why and how questions. Consider using the mini question hand to support.
D Distancing Prompts	The adult models answering distancing questions relating to pictures and words, to their own experiences in the world and ask children to do the same, e.g. <i>Have you ever</i>
