(WHITE LEE AVENUE, TRAWDEN, PENDLE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of White Lee Avenue, Trawden from its junction with Skipton Road to outside 1 White Lee Avenue.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0830 hours until 1630 hours on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2026 until Friday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. No diversion available due to the location of the works

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out.
