## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(LONG HEYS LANE, DALTON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Long Heys Lane, Dalton to a point 512 metres north of its junction with Beacon Lane, for a distance of 370 metres in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 to 1700 hours on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> January until Friday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. There is no diversion available.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Telecom civils works to be carried out.
