ST GEORGES ROAD, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of St Georges Road, Preston for traffic travelling in a westerly direction from its junction with Deepdale Road to its junction with St Anthony's Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Deepdale Road – Sir Tom Finney Way – Blackpool Road – Garstang Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new fire hydrant installation works to be carried out.
