(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of St Georges Road, Preston for traffic travelling in a westerly direction from its junction with Deepdale Road to its junction with St Anthony's Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours Monday 2nd February 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 6th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Deepdale Road – Sir Tom Finney Way – Blackpool Road – Garstang Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new fire hydrant installation works to be carried out.
