(SALT PIT LANE, MAWDESLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Salt Pit Lane, Mawdesley from its junction with Blue Stone Lane, Mawdesley for a distance of 110 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 23rd February 2026 until 1600 hours on Friday 6th March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Salt Pit Lane – Ridley Lane – Dark Lane – Blue Stone Lane and Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works to be carried out to install and joint cable for new supply.
