(RIVINGTON LANE, RIVINGTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rivington Lane, Rivington from the entrance to 'Top o' th Hill Farm for a distance of 40 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 9th February 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 13th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Rivington Lane – Lever Park Avenue – A673 Scholes Bank - A673 Bolton Road – Roscoe Lowe Brow – Horrobin Lane – Rivington Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works to be carried out to install new connections.
