
(RILEY STREET, EARBY, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Riley Street, Earby from its junction with Chapel Street to outside St Peters Methodist Church.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2026 until 1800 hours on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Chapel Street – Stoney Bank Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new electrical connection works to be carried out.
