## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(HOSCAR MOSS ROAD, LATHOM, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hoscar Moss Road, Lathom to a point of 498 metres south of its junction with Deans Lane for a distance of 40 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> January until 1700 hours on Thursday 8th January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. Due to the nature of the work there will be no access for emergency services.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -Hoscar Moss Road, Ring O Bells Lane, A5209 Lowry Hill Lane, A5209 Course Lane, A5209 Ash Brow, A5209 Alder Lane, B5246 Lancaster Lane, B5246 Chorley Road, B5246 Robins Lane, B5246 Hall Lane, Mains Lane, Wanes Blades Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow disconnection of old lead supply and replace with new water connection.
