(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over the following length of highway:
  - a. Wyke Lane, Scarisbrick from its junction with Pool Hey Lane for a distance 1130 metres in a northerly direction.
  - b. Wyke Lane, Scarisbrick from its junction with The Avenue for a distance of 205 metres in a northerly direction.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 2000 hours on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> December until 0600 hours on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency carriageway repair works to be carried out.
