(PLEX LANE, HALSALL, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Plex Lane, Halsall to a point of 470 metres east of its junction with A5147 Southport Road, Down Holland, for a distance of 208 metres in an easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 12th January until 1700 hours on Friday 6th February 2026 until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:Plex Lane, Rosemary Lane, Bye Lane, B5195 Broad Lane, A5147 Delf
 Lane, A5147 Wanisher Lane, A5147 Southport Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the replacement of loose and damaged stones on the bridge to take place to maintain safety.
