(BOLTON AVENUE, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bolton Avenue, Accrington from its junction with Woodside Road for a distance of 25 metres in a south easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February to 1800 hours on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:- Burnley Road – Higher Gate Road – Lower Gate Road – Station Road – Enfield Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to rebuild sunken water asset chamber works undertaken by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
