NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear 60-94 Lonsdale Street, Nelson from its junction with Earl Street to its junction with Lonsdale Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Tuesday 20th January 2026 until 1630 hours on Wednesday 21st January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

 Lonsdale Street Earl Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out.
