(FRIDAY STREET, CHORLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Friday Street, Chorley from its junction with Steeley Lane, Chorley for a distance of 62 metres in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 9th March 2026 until 1700 hours on Sunday 1st November 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Friday Street – East Way – Steeley Lane and Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to facilitate works to install passenger lifts at Chorley Rail Station.
