(FRIDAY STREET, CHORLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Friday Street, Chorley from its junction with Steeley Lane, Chorley for a distance of 62 metres in a northerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2026 until 1700 hours on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Friday Street – East Way – Steeley Lane and Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to facilitate works to install passenger lifts at Chorley Rail Station.
